The November 2, 2021 City/School Election is fast approaching.

Due to the recent election law changes, the following dates are important for voters to be aware of:

- Pre-registration deadline is Monday, October 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm, after that Election Day Registration rules apply.
- **Absentee ballots can be mailed out starting Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> and continue through Monday, October 18<sup>th</sup>.**
- Voters may vote absentee in the County Auditor's Office beginning Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> and continue until 5:00 pm the day prior to the date of election.
- Absentee ballots must be received by the County Auditor's Office before polls close at 8:00 pm on election day.

For those wishing to vote absentee by mail, absentee ballot request forms are available on the Page County website at [pagecounty.iowa.gov](http://pagecounty.iowa.gov), the Office of the Secretary of State website at [sos.iowa.gov](http://sos.iowa.gov), or feel free to contact the Page County Auditor's office, and an absentee ballot request form can be mailed to you.
