The Page County Board of Supervisors met in session on this 4th day of January 2021, with Alan Armstrong, Chuck Morris, and Jacob Holmes present. On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve the agenda. Present from the public were Angie Dow and John Van Nostrand. Attending via Zoom were Ryan Matheny, Judy Clark, Judy Kennedy, Kaitlynn Holmes, Morgan Hoza, and Wendy Mueller.

The pledge of allegiance was said by all in attendance.

On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve Morris as chair and Armstrong as vice-chairperson. Auditor Wellhausen went through the rest of the resolutions #1-#12. The board then discussed board appointments. Armstrong would like to sit on the Landfill board and Morris would like to move off the Waubonsie board as he feels it is a conflict of interest. After discussion it was agreed Morris would move from the Waubonsie Board to the 4th Judicial board and Armstrong will switch with Morris due to the conflict of interest. Board of Health applications were received from Heather Babe and Wendy Mier. On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Morris, the board moved to approve Heather Babe to the Board of Health for a three-year term until 2023. Roll call Armstrong, aye, Morris, aye, Holmes, nay based on the fact that Mier applied and is a Page County resident. Holmes would rather approve a person from the county to the Board of Health. The board next discussed the Conservation Board. Mark Marriott, Steve Rubin, Bill Robinson, and Jane Stimson all applied. Bill Robinson has served in the past but now works seasonally for Conservation. On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve Mark Marriott to the Conservation Board. Holmes stated Stimson would also be an excellent candidate. Roll call vote Armstrong, aye, Morris, aye, Holmes, aye. Motion carried 3 to 0. SWIPCO board was next discussed and AJ Lyman was re-appointed. As for Western Iowa Tourism, Elaine Farwell was re-appointed for the term expiring in 2022. The Zoning Board of Adjustment was next discussed. Those that applied were Kalen Fulk, Ross Farwell, Dale Fulk, Jim O'Hara, Jesse Stimson, and Myron Sunderman. On a motion by Holmes, seconded by Armstrong, the board moved to approve Dale Fulk to the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Armstrong, nay, Morris, nay, Holmes, aye. Motion failed 1 to 2. On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Morris, the board moved to approve Jim O'Hara to the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Armstrong, aye, Morris, aye, Holmes, aye. Motion carried 3 to 0. On a motion by Armstrong seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve resolutions #1 through #12 with the changes and appointments mentioned above.

**RESOLUTION #11-2021
CONSTRUCTION EVALUATION RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3), sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a "construction evaluation resolution" relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR's decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2021 and January 31, 2022 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PAGE COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

King updated the board. He stated no rock is currently being hauled. The blades are out and there is lots of cleanup in the intersections. Crews are burning brush. The budget has been submitted and he is working on a budget amendment. EWP project sites #10 and #9 are being worked on. The crew is replacing the steel deck on the T-13 bridge and work is also being done on the B-61 bridge. King has applied for county bridge construction funds for P-8 and should hear back from the state in January whether it was accepted. Morris stated that a traveler from Stanton noticed that the Stanton road once he entered Page County was bladed much better than the county north of Page County. Holmes also stated he received a call.

Erdman provided a COVID update. She stated there have been 1739 cases, 15 deaths, and the positivity rating has increased to 17.2%. Public Health is still working on vaccinating the health care workers and have administered 120 total vaccinations. Vaccinations may be coming soon for teachers, law enforcement, and essential workers. Public Health is not currently taking a list. Erdman stated it will be a group effort with the hospitals to ensure the vaccinations run smoothly. Holmes questioned how long people have been sick with COVID. Erdman stated people are asked to isolate for 10 days. Morris questioned why Holmes chooses not to wear a mask in the meetings. Holmes stated he is in his space and six feet from everyone. Holmes read part of the Governor's proclamation from December and stated he is following the guidelines.

Wendy Mueller from West Central met with the board to go over the West Central services provided in the prior year. West Central is requesting \$3,500 from Page County.

On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes the board moved to approve the SWIPCO COVID Recovery Partnership with Economic Development Letter of

Support. This provides support for the Shenandoah Chamber and Industry Association and the Clarinda Economic Development Corporation.

The board next discussed the appointment/re-appointment of township clerks and trustees. Mark Slough, Colfax Trustee, Ronald Allen and Douglas Johnson, Douglas Trustees, Duane Hartstack and Kam Hartstack, East River Trustees, Bernard Fischer and Lyle Palmer, Grant Trustees, Russell Herzberg, Harlan Clerk, Brian Brockman and Marvin Reents, Harlan Trustees, Gary Huseman and Keith Huseman, Lincoln Trustees, Donald Nelson and Pat Athen, Morton Trustees, Seth Kirchner and Jeff Sederburg, Nebraska Trustees, Jon Herzberg and Doyle Wagoner, Nodaway Trustees, Donald Woodin and Donald Holmes, Pierce Trustees, Aaron Linke, Tarkio Clerk, Steve Berning and Bill Annan, Tarkio Trustees, James Olenius and Jeremy Robberts, Valley Trustees and Ronald Saye and Troy Edwards, Washington Trustees. On a motion by Holmes, seconded by Armstrong, the board moved to approve the appointments/re-appointments.

On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve the grant funding and allow Page County to be a pass through for the Page County Fair from the Robert Holmes Charitable Fund #4 through the Omaha Community Foundation. The county will receive a total of \$35,000 and the Page County Fair will receive a total of \$60,000.

The board went through and reviewed the claims. On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve the claims.

Judy Clark questioned the township trustees pay, saying they have been paid for years. She stated initially it was \$10 and then increased to \$15. She feels that Morris needs to do his research before just repeating things.

On a motion by Armstrong, seconded by Holmes, the board moved to approve the minutes from December 29th, 2020.
