

NOTICE OF ELECTION TO RENEW

LOCAL OPTION SALES AND SERVICE TAX

I, Shelly Barber, Henry County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections of Henry County, State of Iowa, do hereby certify the following Notices of the Ballot Propositions concerning the imposition of the Local Option Sales and Service Tax in Henry County at the General Election to be held November 4, 2014.

FOR THE CITY OF COPPOCK: "Shall the City of Coppock, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for 100% Property Tax Relief. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF HILLSBORO: "Shall the City of Hillsboro, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Community Betterment. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF MT PLEASANT: "Shall the City of Mt Pleasant, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Capital Improvements? The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF MT UNION: "Shall the City of Mt Union, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Road Use Tax in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) Garbage Collections in the amount of three thousand one hundred dollars (\$3,100) and remainder of tax proceeds shall be put into the General Fund. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF NEW LONDON: "Shall the City of New London, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Community Betterment. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF OLDS: "Shall the City of Olds, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Capital Projects. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF ROME: "Shall the City of Rome, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Community Development, Street Maintenance, Town Improvements and Maintenance. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF SALEM: "Shall the City of Salem, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Capital Improvements, Tax Relief. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF WAYLAND: "Shall the City of Wayland, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for any lawful purpose. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF WESTWOOD: "Shall the City of Westwood, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for Capital Improvements and Community Development. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE CITY OF WINFIELD: "Shall the City of Winfield, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for 100% Property Tax Relief. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."

FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF HENRY COUNTY: "Shall the unincorporated area of Henry County, Iowa levy a one percent (1%) sales tax of which the sales tax proceeds shall be used for the benefit of the rural residents to include Rural Garbage Service and Community Betterment for Henry County. The tax shall commence effective January 1, 2016 with no sunset date."
