Residents of Jackson County can now call the Information Line for the most current information on COVID-19 vaccinations. This pre-recorded message will be updated as needed when information changes, no message can be left.

The latest message has been provided by Michele Cullen our Community Health Manager as of February 22nd. Last week in Jackson County, we only received half of our allocations due to the bad weather in the south. We are expecting those allocations and this week's allocations to arrive Tuesday/Wednesday. We are working hard to get last week's clinics rescheduled and stay on target for this week's clinics. We continue to serve those over 65 and essential workers in the Phase 1b category.

Please note provider information remains the same - Osterhaus Pharmacy, Hartig Drug in Bellevue and Preston, Maquoketa Family Clinic, and Bellevue Medical Associates

Jackson County is expecting more allocations to arrive Wednesday instead of Tuesday this week due to weather and President's Day. Our allocation continues to be small, but the allocation is the same as last week. Please note providers are the same as last week. We continue to serve those over 65 and Tier 1 in Phase 1B. Updates will be weekly or as more vaccines come into the county. (Note pre-recorded message did not change as content is the same)

2-10-21

As of February 10th, Jackson County Public Health reports that the COVID-19 vaccine continues to be in high demand with low supply. The good news is the state told us we will receive a steady supply of 400 doses each week during the month of February and those doses will arrive on Tuesdays. We will continue to get this amount so long as providers are getting 80% into the residents' arms.

So far, we have received 2 shipments of 400 for the first 2 weeks. Approximately, half of each shipment is going towards the target population of 65 years of age or older. Provider sites for

the general public in our county include: Osterhaus Pharmacy in Maquoketa, Hartig Pharmacies in both Bellevue and Preston, Bellevue- Medical Associates, and the Maquoketa Family Clinic.

Public Health is currently focusing on Tier 1 Essential worker vaccinations for schools, childcare and Law enforcement settings. They will be starting in those facilities this week. Please note that ALL schools in Jackson County are scheduled in February.
