TITLE: Disposal of Low Value and Recurring Items

DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND:

Whereas, the County Road Department often has items that have a residual value after being replaced; and

Whereas, these miscellaneous items of low value are also frequently needed to be disposed of and the County would like to have a simple method to capture some of the residual value instead of hauling these items to the landfill or other means of disposal, and

Whereas, the cost of advertising can often be greater than the residual value of the items;

Therefore the Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Road Department to be able to dispose of low value items in the following manor:

- Specify standard recurring items: County will set the list of items and values annually and publish the list on the Courthouse bulletin board and County website, examples of recurring items are used culvert pipe, broken 4x4 or 4x6 sign posts, used bridge plank, etc.
- Miscellaneous items available for sale will be posted on the Courthouse Bulletin Board outside the Engineer's office and the County website with a minimum acceptable bid price and the last date and time that bids will be accepted. Items will be posted for a two (2) week period.
- Nothing in this policy requires the Road Department to sell items that it wishes to retain for repurposing or reuse at a later date.
