GENERAL ELECTION TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020

Voter pre-registration deadline is October 24th , 2020 for the General Election that will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

Due to the current COVID 19 pandemic, some polling places will be combined and there will be a limited number of precinct election officials serving at the polls. This will cause voters to wait longer at the polling place to cast your ballots. The Auditor’s Office is encouraging voters to vote by absentee. ***Notice of polling place change:** *Hartford I/Sumner and Hartford II/Lincoln polling places have been temporarily combined and moved and voters will vote at the Iowa County Secondary Road Shop, 105 East St, Ladora, IA.*

***Notice of polling place change:** *Honey Creek/Marengo Rural and Marengo City polling places have been temporarily combined and moved and voters will vote at the Iowa Valley Elementary School, 151 E May St, Marengo, IA.*

Election Day Registration took effect on January 1, 2008. This means you may now register at your precinct on Election Day if you have moved. If you plan to register on Election Day, you will need to provide proof of identity (photo ID), proof of residency (your current address in the precinct), and sign an oath. This process will take extra time at the polling place. **Voters are still encouraged to pre-register by October 24th in the auditor’s office if your residence has changed.**

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts

also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification. Anyone wishing to vote absentee before Election Day may do so by stopping in the Auditor's Office Monday thru Friday 8:00 am until 4:30 pm or Saturday, October 24th, 8:00 am until 5:00 pm or Saturday, October 31st, 9:00 am until 5:00 pm. Voter Registration and Absentee Ballot Request Forms are also available by mail or on the web at www.co.iowa.ia.us . For further information, please contact the Auditor's Office at 319-642-3923.

Voting Equipment Testing will begin on Wednesday, October, 21st at 9:00 am at the East Courthouse Annex in Marengo.

Sample ballots for the General Election will be published the week of October 18th.
