

SPECIAL CLARINDA SCHOOL ELECTION NOTICE

Public notice is hereby given that a Special Clarinda School Election will be held on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at a temporary polling location, within the Clarinda School District, at which a Revenue Purpose Statement will be submitted to the voters.

If a majority of eligible electors voting on the question fail to approve this Revenue Purpose Statement, then upon expiration of the current Revenue Purpose Statement, revenues received by the School District from the Secure an Advanced Vision for Education fund shall be expended in the following order:

The payment of bonds for which SAVE Revenue has been pledged;

Reduction of bond levies under Iowa Code Sections 298.18 and 298.18A and all other debt levies;

Reduction of the regular and voter-approved physical plant and equipment levy under Iowa Code Section 298.2;

Reduction of the public educational and recreational levy under Iowa Code Section 300.2;

For any authorized infrastructure purpose of the school district as defined in Iowa Code Section 423F.3(6); and

For the payment of principal and interest on bonds issued under Iowa Code Sections 423E.5 and 423F.4.

The polls in the voting precinct will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. Voting locations have temporarily changed for voters. Clarinda 1 and Clarinda 2; Page County Courthouse 1 which includes Yorktown and portions of Douglas, Nodaway and Valley Townships located within the Clarinda Community School District; Page County Courthouse 2 which includes Nebraska and portions of Buchanan, East River and Harlan Townships located within the Clarinda Community School District; Shenandoah Fire Station which includes portions of Linco0ln and Tarkio Townships located within the Clarinda Community School District

***Notice of polling place change:** The Page County Courthouse 1 & 2 and Shenandoah Fire Station polling locations have been combined at the temporary polling place, Clarinda Lied Library, for this election.

All polling places are handicapped accessible, however, any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. Please contact the Page County Auditor's Office at 712-542-3219 for assistance.

All voters are required to present an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. For more information about voter identification visit <https://sos.iowa.gov/voterid> or call 712-542-3219.

Iowa law allows eligible persons to register and vote at the polls on Election Day. An Election Day registrant must provide acceptable proof of identity and current residence in the precinct. Voters choosing this option should plan to take a few extra minutes for this transaction.

Public testing for the voting equipment will be held Tuesday, August 30, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. at the Auditor's Office.
