The Page County Board of Supervisors met in session on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 2020, with Jon Herzberg and Alan Armstrong present. Present from the public were Tom Nordhues, Jesse Stimson, Ryan Matheny, and Tim Johnson. Attending via zoom were JD King, Heidi Hertensen, Mark Zaccone, and Mike Petersen.

King gave a roads update. There are three trucks hauling rock. Blades are out in all districts. The spray patcher is working on J55 east of Braddyville. The crew will be pulling the magnet. The pipe crew is working on 160<sup>th</sup> and next will go to J53 and M44.
