

**NOTICE OF CITY/SCHOOL ELECTION
NOVEMBER 2, 2021**

Monroe County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections, Amanda R. Harlan, hereby gives notice that there will be a CITY/SCHOOL ELECTION in Monroe County, Iowa on November 2, 2021. Qualified electors of Monroe County will vote at the polling places designated below for the purpose of electing mayors, city council members, school board members and to vote on public measures.

The Polls will open at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 pm, as provided by law, at the following locations:

DESIGNATION OF POLLING PLACES



1. Precincts 1-5, Monroe County Courthouse, 10 Benton Ave East, Albia, IA 52531 – Albia City, Moravia City and Eddyville City and Guilford, Troy, Pleasant, Mantua, Monroe and Urbana Townships
2. Precinct 6, Lovilia Community Center, 608 West 17th St, Lovilia, IA 50150 – Lovilia City and Cedar, Union and Bluff Creek Townships
3. Precinct 7, St. Patrick’s Church, 200 Shamrock St, Melrose, IA 52569 – Melrose City and Wayne, Jackson and Franklin Townships

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter’s vehicle. For further information, please contact the County Auditor’s Office at telephone number (641) 932-2865 or email aharlan@monroecoia.us. For TTY access, dial 711 + (641) 932-2865.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter’s identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor’s office by 12:00 noon on Monday, November 8, 2021. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. The automatic tabulating equipment to count the votes cast will be publicly tested in the Auditor’s Office at the Monroe County Courthouse, 10 Benton Ave E, Albia, Iowa on Thursday, October 21, 2021, at 9:00 am.
