Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of Iowa County, Iowa, that the Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. The polls will be open from 7:00 AM until 9:00 PM. The voting places in each precinct for said election are as follows:

Voters within Marengo City and Honey Creek, Marengo, Hilton and Washington townships will vote the ballot showing District 075 State Representative candidate Ruby Bodeker on the Democratic Ballot and Thomas Gerhold on the Republican Ballot. The remainder of the county will vote the ballot showing District 076 State Representative candidate Sarah Smith on the Democratic Ballot and David E. Maxwell on the Republican Ballot.

Iowa Code Section 49.31 requires that candidate names be rotated amongst all precincts. Therefore, placement of candidate names may be in a different order in your precinct than on this sample ballot.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by Noon on Thursday, June 4, 2020. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. For additional information about providing proof of identity and/or residence visit:
