Primary Election Absentee Voting**

Absentee ballots for the June 7, 2022, Primary Election will be available in the Monroe County Auditor's Office beginning Wednesday, May 18, 2022.

Voters wishing to receive a ballot by mail for the Primary Election will need to complete an absentee ballot request form and return it to the Monroe County Auditor's Office, 10 Benton Ave E, Albia, IA, by 5 pm on May 23, 2022.
