Dust Control

Please make sure to read the Dust Control Policy that is available on the website. There is a lot of helpful and required information listed.

A couple of quick facts:

- All permits must be submitted by May 1st of each dust control season. After this date any applications that are submitted will need to pay a \$25 late fee. Be sure to have your permit turned in the dust control company so that they have time to get them turned into the FC Road Department by May 1st.
- There is a list of all the Approved Dust Control companies on the website. These companies have filled out all documents and submitted insurance and are approved to apply dust control in Fayette County. Please contact them for their prices and for the permit to fill out.
- Fayette County will furnish, upon request, temporary cardboard signs to stake the limits of the dust control treatment and the maintenance and shaping of the road prior to the dust control being applied.
- The treated portion of the road will not be maintained before October 15th as long as this portion of the road is smooth and free of pot holes. If pot holes develop, maintaining will be done using the material within the limits of the dust treatment when moisture is present.

Iowa law specifies, “the purpose of a public highway is to serve the traveling public”. Dust treatments after October 15th or those left rough by residents will be scarified and maintained as a rock surface.
