Public test/demonstration of Howard County's voting equipment, as to how the votes will be counted for the Primary Election will be held at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 28, 2020, in the Election Room in the basement of the Courthouse.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by June 8, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. (noon). Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
