

SIGN MAINTENANCE PERSON

JOB SUMMARY:

Iowa County Secondary Roads supervises all secondary roads within Iowa County, these consist of mostly roads that are; outside city limits, not interstates, and not state highways. Under general supervision of the County Engineer; to perform rough carpentry work and duties related to erecting, repairing, and taking down highway signs; and to perform other related duties as required.

FACILITY AND WORK AREA:

East Yard in Marengo, Iowa.

JOB FUNTIONS

Operate equipment to construct and maintain Iowa County's signs in compliance with MUTCD and Iowa County standards.

Example of Essential Job Functions:

Travels the road system to evaluate the need for new signs and sign repairs to meet uniform guidelines. The following are a list of duties that are required, but not limited to:

- Repair signs.
- Replace and straighten posts.
- Replace or clean sign faces.
- Keep computer records of all locations, history, & inventory of all signs.
- Determine Type, Size, & Location of signs per MUTCD and other manuals.
- Conduct Iowa One Calls.
- Use hand tools and power equipment.
- Install, repair, & take down barricades & other temporary traffic control devices.
- Fabricate signs & blanks.
- Keep site, tools, & equipment clean and orderly.
- Perform routine maintenance on sign truck.
- Assist with snow removal when needed.
- May be required to work after hours during snow and emergency events.

Other Job Functions:

Physical Characteristics of the Job: This position can be classified as Very Heavy Work requiring exertion of up to one hundred (100) pounds of force occasionally. The successful candidate will need a physician's release regarding the Essential Job Function Analysis Form below.

Environmental Conditions: The work is performed both inside and outside and includes seasonal exposure to cold and heat. The worker is exposed to darkness and poor lighting, fumes/odors, isolation, moving machinery, noise, visual strain, and working on uneven grounds. Also, the work may expose the employee to significant work pace pressure, and irregular hours.

Visual Requirements: Employees must meet and maintain visual requirements to obtain a Commercial Driver License from the State of Iowa.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a Legal U.S. Citizen.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must have clean driving record.
- Must pass a background check.
- Possession of and maintain a valid Iowa CDL (Class A or B) for equipment operated.
- Must pass department physical ability test.
- Knowledge of the operation and mechanical functions of a truck.
- Knowledge of the operating hazards and the applicable safety precautions in the operation of a truck
- Ability to operate heavy trucks and perform manual labor for extended periods of time.
- Knowledge of the practices of vehicle maintenance.
- Two years of experience driving a truck; or any equivalent combination of training and experience, which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.

Iowa County retains the authority to change the job duties included in this job description at any time. The list of duties is not exhaustive and various requirements are subject to possible modification as a reasonable accommodation for a qualified individual.
