Explanation of increases in the budget:

Proposed Percentage Change is due to increase in taxable valuations. The levy rates for the General, General Supplemental and Rural Funds will remain the same as the prior year. Expenditures include expected increases in operation and maintenance costs and cost of living adjustments.
