

Treasurer's Office Property Taxes: Property taxes can be paid online at www.iowatreasurers.org . The fee for an e-check is \$0.25. Other methods include: sending the payment by mail or using the drop box located on the South side of the courthouse.

No payments for property tax will be accepted in person. Tax payment penalty and interest will be imposed beginning June 26, 2020.

Treasurer's Office Driver's License: Services available by appointment only. Appointments can be scheduled by calling our office at 712.542.5310 *Walk in customers will not be served and drive exams are not being offered at this time.

If your driver's license has an expiration date prior to March 28, 2020 it becomes invalid for driving purposes beginning June, 26 2020.

If you need to renew your driver's license, we encourage you to try to renew online at <https://iowadot.gov/mvd/driverslicense/renew>. You do have 60 days after the expiration date on your driver's license to renew.

If you need to get the REAL ID, we ask that you consider waiting until concerns regarding the COVID-19 Virus subside. **You will not need the REAL ID for domestic travel until October 1, 2021.**

Teen driver's now have the option to take the web-knowledge test at home. Parents will need to apply to administer the test by visiting www.iowadot.gov Once the student has passed the test they can schedule an appointment to be issued their permit.

Young driver's upgrading from a learner's permit to an intermediate license or intermediate to full driver's license have the option to receive them remotely. A parent must complete the remote consent form which can be found at www.iowadot.gov. The family will be contacted by phone to complete the process. The child will then receive the license in the mail.

Misplaced your license or recently moved and need your address changed those transactions can be completed remotely. Please call our office for assistance.

Treasurer's Office Title Transfers: If you purchased a new or used vehicle you can obtain a title and registration from our office between the hours of 8:30-4:00 Monday thru Friday.

If you purchased a vehicle between February 13 and March 14, 2020 please visit: <https://iowadot.gov/covid-19/pdfs/VS-AppendixA.pdf> to determine when late penalties will begin to be assessed. If your purchase occurred on or after March 15 the deadline to avoid penalties is July 27.

Treasurer's Office Motor Vehicle: The best way to pay motor vehicle registration renewals is online. Registrations can be paid online at www.iowatreasurers.org. The fee for an e-check is \$0.25. Other method include: sending the payment by mail or using the drop box located on the South side of the courthouse.

No payments for motor vehicle registration renewals will be accepted in person. If your registration was due December 31, 2019 or before your registration is not covered by the emergency waiver and penalties will accrue as normal. If your registration was due Jan 31, Feb 29, March 31, April 30, or May 31 your new expiration date will be June 30 and you have a grace period for the month of July. If you do not pay on or before July 31 penalties will be assessed beginning August 3.
